## Former Woodland Hills Golf Course Property Acquired by Township

Lower Saucon Township, PA – October 31, 2014: Lower Saucon Township announced that it had finalized the purchase of the 148-acre former Woodland Hill Golf Course property effective October 31, 2014. The property, which is located between Lower Saucon Road and Countryside Lane, was acquired as open space and will be allowed to revert to its natural state with no plans for the construction of any active recreation features or facilities on the property. Funding for the acquisition came from a \$742,000 grant from DCNR, a \$300,000 grant from the Northampton County Open Space Fund, and Township open space funds. The Township will be providing access to the site from Countryside Lane and grass trails on the property will allow visitors to hike, bird watch and enjoy the natural beauty of the tract. This acquisition will increase the total preserved parcels in the Township to over 541 acres.
