

## **PennEast Pipeline Preferred Alternative Route – Mapping Tool Available**

Dear Stakeholder,

PennEast partners, engineers and outreach staff has had numerous conversations with various stakeholders and received significant feedback on the route that was proposed in August 2014. Those conversations, coupled with further computer analysis and meetings with regulators, elected officials and resource agencies, led us to reconsider the original route and propose a refined alternative route. Due to this reroute, letters have been sent to landowners along the new preferred alternative route and letters will also be mailed to landowners no longer impacted. As I have stated earlier, we are still in the very early stages of the routing and regulatory process. That said, PennEast will continue to evaluate route options throughout FERC's review process.

The interactive mapping tool was updated today and reflects the survey corridor associated with the current preferred alternative route. The following link will lead you directly to the revised interactive mapping tool:
