In August, PennEast Pipeline Company, LLC, announced plans to construct the PennEast Pipeline Project. This approximately 108-mile, 36-inch diameter, natural gas pipeline will originate near Dallas, Luzerne County, in northeastern Pennsylvania, and terminate at an interconnection with Transco's pipeline near Pennington, Mercer County, New Jersey.
