

Saucon Rail Trail Memorial Bench Program Policy

Lower Saucon Township

Adopted August 17, 2011

Please be advised that as of May 21, 2012, all seven (7) bench locations have been taken. We will consider adding more benches in the future.

- A program whereby individuals and organizations can purchase a memorial bench that will be located along the Lower Saucon Township portion of the Saucon Rail Trail.
- Seven (7) locations have been selected initially along the 1.4 mile Lower Saucon Township section of the trail. The locations are purposely remote from any residences abutting the trail to avoid any disturbance. Depending on the popularity of the program more locations may be selected in the future.
- Bench locations will be selected by Lower Saucon Township
- The approved color for the benches is green
- The program will be limited to individuals and local Saucon Valley organizations. No commercial sponsorships will be accepted.
- Individuals and organizations purchasing the benches will make payment directly to Eternal Products who will assemble the bench, prepare the engraved memorial plaque and install the bench at the location chosen on the Rail Trail. No costs will be incurred by the Township.
- The benches selected are very durable, will be anchored securely, and should withstand normal usage by trail users. However, if the bench is damaged or stolen, the Township will not be responsible for its repair or replacement.
