3:00 PM: Roads Impacted by Flooding in East Central Pennsylvania

Motorists in eastern central Pennsylvania are advised several roads are impacted in the area due to flooding. The following roads currently are closed as of 3:00 PM.

Berks County

- PA 625 between Philadelphia and Mt. View roads in Cumru Township
- PA 724 between Furnace Street in Birdsboro Borough and Shed Road in Union Township;
- (complete)PA 61 North between Lake Shore and Indian Manor drives in Ontelaunee Township;
- Belleman's Church Road between Garfield and Indian Trail roads in Centre Township;
- Leesport Avenue between Snyder Road and Huller Lane in Ontelaunee Township;
- (complete) Main Street between Cross Keys Road in Bern Township and Wall Street in Leesport Borough;
- (new) PA 724 between Unionville Road in Union Township and Scholl Road in North Coventry Township, Chester County.

Lehigh County

- Haasadahl Road between Becker Street and Hickory Lane in Upper Macungie Township;
- Vera Cruz Road between Limeport Pike and Pam Road in Lower Milford Township;
- Limeport Pike between Bell Gate Road and Chestnut Hill Church Road in Lower Milford Township;
- (new) Schantz Road between Hamilton Boulevard in Lower Macungie Township and Cetronia Road in Upper Macungie Township;
- (new) Indian Creek Road between Macungie Road in Lower Macungie Township and Cedar Crest Boulevard in Upper Milford Township;
- (new) Spring Creek Road between Trexlertown and Mill Creek roads in Lower Macungie Township;
- (new) Cetronia Road between Schantz Road (east) and Schantz Road (west) in Upper Macungie Township;
- (new) Trexlertown Road North between Hamilton Boulevard and US 222 in Upper Macungie Township.

Monroe County

- Locust Ridge Road between Cherry Blossom Lane and Lackawanna County Line in Coolbaugh Township.

Northampton County

- Raubsville Road between Hexenkoph and Morgan Hill roads in Williams Township;
- Durham Road between Coffeetown and Raubsville roads in Williams Township.

Schuylkill County

- Fountain Road between PA 125 in Frailey Township and PA 25 Hegins Township (closed since previous storm);
- Helfenstein Road between Hunter Road in Eldred Township and High Road in Butler Township (closed since previous storm);
- PA 125 between Scenic and Creek roads in Eldred Township (closed since previous storm);
- Dutchtown Road between Barry and Tiley roads in Eldred Township; US 209 between Coal and Wood streets in Port Carbon Borough;
- Market Street between US 209 in Port Carbon Borough and 7th Street in East Norwegian Township;
- Pottsville Street between East Norwegian Street in Mechanicsville Borough and Market Street in Port Carbon Borough;
- Darkwater Road between Peach Mountain Road and PA 61 in New Castle Township; Main Street between PA 924 and Borough Line in Gilberton Borough;
- (new) PA 645 between Roberts and Unknown roads in Pine Grove Township;
- (new) PA 895 between Veterans Memorial Drive and Marstown Alley in Pine Grove Township;
- (new) PA 443 between Laurel Street and Pine Grove MFG Homes in Pine Grove Borough.
