## 2013 Dog Licenses Available at County Offices

Residents can purchase 2013 dog licenses from the County Treasurer beginning Saturday, December 1, 2012. State law requires all dogs that are three (3) months and older to be licensed by January 1<sup>st</sup> each year.

An annual license is \$8.45 and a lifetime license is \$51.45. If the animal is spayed or neutered, the annual fee is \$6.45 and the lifetime is \$31.45. Discounts are available to older adults and people with disabilities.

A new website, <u>http://www.licenseyourdogPA.com</u> will provide access to a dog license application, county treasurer contact information, Pennsylvania's dog laws, and an on-line tip form.

Owners who fail to license their dogs could face a fine of up to \$300 for each unlicensed dog.
