What:

An opportunity for the public to surrender expired, unwanted, or unused pharmaceutical controlled substances and other medications to law enforcement officers for destruction. They can be prescriptions or over the counter medications. Products accepted: prescription and over-the-counter solid medications, i.e. tablets and capsules. Liquid medications, inhalers, creams, ointments, nasal sprays. Pet medications. Products NOT accepted: Intravenous solutions, injectables and needles. Illicit substances such as marijuana or methamphetamine.

This program is absolutely anonymous and all efforts will be made to protect the anonymity of individuals disposing of medications. No questions or requests for identification will be made by law enforcement personnel present.

Participants will remove any personal information from bottles or packages that contain pills/capsules and liquids and place the bottles or packages into the disposal box.
