

ID Cards Required for Saucon Valley Compost Center

Effective in 2012, ID Cards will be required for Hellertown Borough and Lower Saucon Township residents who use the Compost Center.

The Yard Waste Recycling Committee, which oversees the operation of the Compost Center, is implementing this requirement in order to expedite check-ins at the Compost Center entrance gate. The new ID card, which can be displayed to the gate attendant by residents, will be much faster than the sign-in procedure that has been used for the past several years, especially since many of the users make repeated visits to the facility during the Friday – Saturday operating schedule.

ID Cards will be issued on a walk-in basis at both the Hellertown Borough Hall and at the Lower Saucon Township Municipal Building during the following times.

- Hellertown Borough – 685 Main Street, Hellertown, PA 18055
Monday – Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Lower Saucon Township – 3700 Old Philadelphia Pike, Bethlehem, PA 18055
Monday – Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

ID Cards will also be issued at the Compost Center gate on Fridays and Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. beginning April 13, 2012.
