

Northampton County Moves to Green Phase on Friday, June 26, 2020

What the green phase means:

- Continued Telework Strongly Encouraged
- Businesses with In-Person Operations Must Follow Business and Building Safety Requirements
- All Businesses May Increase to 75% Occupancy
- Child Care May Open Complying with Guidance
- Congregate Care Restrictions in Place
- Prison and Hospital Restrictions Determined by Individual Facilities and Commonwealth Guidance

Social Restrictions:

- Large gatherings of more than 250 prohibited.
- Masks are required in businesses.
- Restaurants and bars open at 50% occupancy. Bar seating will be permitted, but you must stay at least six feet away from each other or the bar must have a physical barrier between customers. Four people with a common relationship can sit together at the bar.
- Personal Care Services including hair salons and barbershops can open at 50% occupancy and by appointment only.
- Indoor recreation, health and wellness facilities and personal care services (such as gyms and spas) can open at 50%.
- All entertainment such as casinos, theaters and shopping malls can open at 50% occupancy.
- Construction activities may return to full capacity with continued implementation of protocols.
