

Saucon Rail Trail (Under Development)

September 2010 Update – Lower Saucon Township Trail Portion

At the September 15, 2010 Council meeting, the Township awarded a contract for fencing for the Rail Trail to Pro Max Fence Systems, Inc. of Reading, PA in the amount of \$17,757 to install 690 linear feet of wood rail fencing on the two (2) bridges spanning the Saucon Creek at Old Mill Road and north of Meadows Road, and over a culvert south of Bingen Road. A traffic study prepared by the Township Engineer recommended that stop signs, rather than flashing lights, could be installed at the Meadows Road trail crossing. The Township anticipates that this construction will be started shortly.
