

Reading Drive Trailhead Dedication and Ribbon Cutting



On June 8, 2013, the Township Council and Saucon Rail Trail representatives officially opened the newly constructed Reading Drive Trailhead with a dedication and ribbon cutting ceremony at the site, which is located off of Reading Drive at the intersection with Bingen Road.



The new trailhead, which was purchased with State and Open Space funding, and constructed by the Township Public Works Department, is adjacent to the Saucon Rail Trail and midway between the Hellertown Borough and Upper Saucon Township trailheads on the current 5-mile Phase I portion of this trail. The trailhead has 20 parking spaces, toilet facilities and a picnic area for trail users.
