LATEX PAINT MUST MEET THESE REQUIREMENTS:

- MUST BE LATEX PAINT
- PAINT MUST BE IN ORIGINAL CONTAINERS
- PAINT MUST BE LIQUID
- PAINT MUST BE LESS THAN OR EQUAL TO 10 YEARS OLD
- MUST BE RECYCLABLE (REFER TO ""UNACCEPTABLE (NON-RECYCLABLE) LATEX PAINT" LIST)

WE DO NOT ACCEPT:

- OIL (ALKYD) OR SOLVENT-BASED PAINT
- STAINS OR POLYURETHANES
- PORCH OR FLOOR PAINTS
- WATER PROOFING PAINT e.g. DRYLOCK
- SPECIALTY PAINTS, e.g.:
 - INDUSTIRAL
 - MARINE
 - AUTOMOTIVE
 - TRAFFIC-MARKING
 - GLAZES/TEXTURES

Oil-based paint is Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) take to HHW event.



*UNACCEPTABLE (NON-RECYCLABLE) LATEX PAINT INCLUDES:

- PREVIOUSLY FROZEN
- CONTAINING BIOLOGICAL GROWTH
- PRESENCE OF PAINT SKIN
- HARDENED
- SIGNIFICANT CONTAINER CORROSION
- DEBRIS, SUCH AS DIRT, SAND, GRAVEL, SAWDUST, OR PAPER, FTC.

OPTIONS TO DISPOSE OF NON-RECYCLABLE LATEX PAINT:

- Mix with cat litter, saw
 dust, shredded paper or commercial
 paint hardener in the container
 dispose with household trash. Place
 container, with lid removed, outside
 trash container or in a clear bag so
 hauler can see paint is solid. Empty
 and dry cans may be recyclable,
 check with your hauler or
 community.
- Or, pour paint out onto newspaper in a thin layer, let paint dry (usually a day or two) and dispose of newspaper with household trash. Empty and dry cans may be recyclable, check with your hauler or community.
- Or, remove lid, let paint dry out and dispose of container according to local regulations (could take several weeks or months). Place container, with lid removed, outside trash container or in a clear bag so hauler can see paint is solid.
