

SAFE BURNING GUIDELINES

- Check the Township website at www.lowersaucontownship.org for burning advisories or call Town Hall at (610) 865-3291.
- Notify the Non-Emergency dispatch by calling (610) 759-2200 prior to burning.
- Select a location away from any dwelling/buildings, utility lines, etc.
- Have fire extinguisher materials on hand including a water supply, shovels and rakes.
- Never use gasoline, kerosene or any other flammable liquid to start a fire because the risk of personal injury is high.
- Burn one small pile in a contained area at a time and slowly add to it. This will help keep the fire from getting out of control.
- Attend the fire until extinguished.
- Always be aware that is the smoke becomes a nuisance to neighboring properties, your neighbors have the right to contact the police to complain.
- Use common sense and be prepared to extinguish your fire if the winds pick up or weather changes. Sudden wind change is how most open burning gets out of control.
- If for some reason, the fire should get out of control, call 9-1-1 immediately.
