Volunteers Needed



ID Cards

In 2013, ID Cards were mailed to Hellertown Borough and Lower Saucon Township residents. PLEASE RETAIN THIS CARD AND CONTINUE TO USE IT AT THE COMPOST CENTER. For other residents who do not have an ID Card, you can register and pick up a card at the Borough or Township offices during regular business hours.

The new multi-year ID card, which can be displayed to the gate attendant by visitors, replaced the sign-in procedure that was used for the past several years. The ID card can be used by all members of the residence it is issued to. The Compost Center reserves the right to confirm the identification of the card holder if there is a suspicion that the card is being misused for non-resident or commercial purposes.

DEP PERMIT

The Center's operation is governed by a permit issued to the Borough and Township by the Pennsylvania DEP which limits the type of material that can be dropped off or removed. Failure to comply with the permit conditions can result in the revocation of our permit. We ask for your cooperation/compliance.

MATERIALS ACCEPTED

- Leaves if in plastic bags, bags must be taken home
- Small Brush up to 4" diameter (no longer than 6 feet)
- Hedge trimmings, garden plants residue

MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTED

- Grass
- Sod
- Tree stumps
- Commercial business materials
- · Stones or concrete
- Manufactured wood and lumber products
- Painted or treated wood

- Plastic bags used to transport materials must be taken home.
- Please reduce your speed on the entrance road and within the Center
- Please be careful when maneuvering your vehicle in the Compost Center yard.
- Grass is not accepted at the Compost Center
 Recycle your grass by using a mulching mower or
 by cutting your lawn frequently and leaving the
 grass on the lawn. This does not contribute to
 thatch and provides an excellent lawn fertilizer.
