

Stormwater Inlets Repaired on Mountain Drive



Drivers taking Mountain Drive North over South Mountain may have noticed that their wheels were no longer driving into the storm sewer depressions that were spaced over the Lower Saucon and City of Bethlehem portions of the mountain road. Sitting several inches below the road surface due to road resurfacing projects over the past 20 years, drivers tried to avoid driving into these depressions, which then forced them close to the centerline of the road. Our Township Public Works crews have been busy this summer replacing and rebuilding 21 of the worst inlets along Mountain Drive North in conjunction with a planned future road resurfacing. Along with the road paving done by the City of Bethlehem on their section of the road, drivers using Mountain Drive should have a safer and more enjoyable ride over South Mountain.
